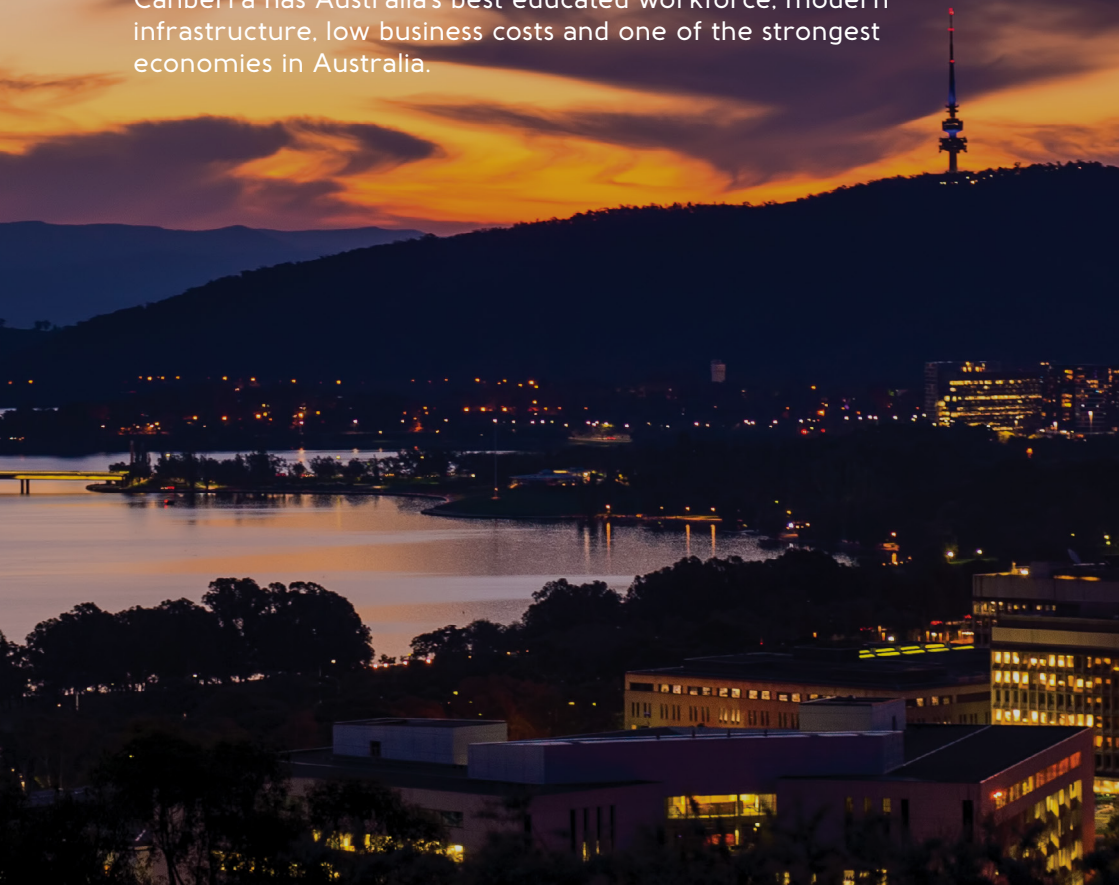


CANBERRA: AUSTRALIA'S CAPITAL CITY

Canberra is the capital city of Australia. The city is strategically located in the Australian Capital Territory (ACT), between Australia's largest cities, Sydney and Melbourne.

Canberra has Australia's best educated workforce, modern infrastructure, low business costs and one of the strongest economies in Australia.



PROSPEROUS, VIBRANT, GROWING

Canberra is a planned and designed city, established in 1913 as Australia's capital city. A scenic city of green spaces, broad boulevards and a seamless alignment of built and natural elements.



Canberra's population is 400,000 and is growing by 5,000 people every year. Canberra is the commercial hub for the wider Canberra region of 900,000 people.

Canberra's population is younger and more culturally diverse than elsewhere in Australia. 23.8% of Canberra's residents were born overseas. By 2020 Canberra will be home to 420,000 people.



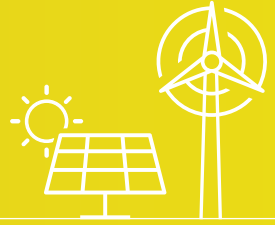
Canberra's economy is strong. Really strong. Economic growth averaged 2.7% per annum over the last decade. In 2015-16 economic growth was 3.4%.

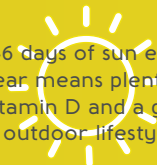

All federal government departments and agencies are located in Canberra.

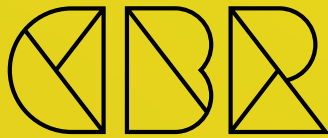


Canberra's International Airport is just 15 minutes from the city centre.
